



### About Camp Allen Summer Camp

Camp Allen's summer Camp program offers the opportunity for 1600 campers, ages 8-18, to experience the unconditional love and friendship of a Christian community through each of our one-week sessions. Our mission is to provide a unique environment for kids to experience God, establish valuable relationships within the camping community and personal growth through a variety of creative, safe, challenging, and fun opportunities.

### Our Staff

Each session is led by a priest, youth minister or experienced adult dedicated to enriching the lives of young people. Campsite activities are led by our college-aged senior staff; they are CPR, First Aid, and Lifeguard certified. Each cabin will have two counselors that remain with the campers 24/7. All of our staff and volunteers have background checks and have been through extensive training that includes Safeguarding God's Children.

### Campsite & Cabin Assignments

Campers are divided into three campsites by age. They will lodge, dine, and participate in activities with their campsites. There is also an all-camp Eucharist on Wednesday night and an all camp dance on Thursday night. Junior High campers stay in dormitory style cabins at Campsite 3, accommodating up to 96 campers per week. All other age groups stay in tree house style cabins in Campsites 1 or 2, accommodating up to 63 campers in each campsite weekly. All cabins have twin bunk beds and are air conditioned. Cabin assignments are made for each session as best meets the needs of the camp and to assist in making new friends. While we cannot guarantee cabin requests, we try to meet as many requests as possible. Cabin requests may be made when the camper is registered and not at check in on Sunday. No group networking is allowed and no more than three friends will be put in the same cabin.

### Health and Safety

Each camper's health and safety is an extremely important part of camp. Camp Allen, licensed by the Texas Department of Health, is highly committed to excellence and safety. An on-site nursing staff is employed to care for ill or injured campers and to distribute all medicines. Our nurses review all forms and will see campers with medications at check-in. Severe allergies must be noted on the health history form. Appropriate medication should accompany camper (i.e. epi-pen). Remember to bring camper medications in their original containers, with pharmacy label.

### Activities & Program

Camp Allen offers the following activities: the Blob, Iceberg, Saturn, canoeing, archery, horseback riding, swimming, low challenge course, high challenge course (Jr. & Sr. High campers only), arts & crafts, campsite games, Bedlam (messy games), initiatives/teambuilding exercises, and hands on outdoor education classes. Activities are scheduled so that each child will have the opportunity to participate in all of them. The session directors will use creative methods such as songs, skits, and art to communicate God's love and the good news of Jesus Christ to campers. Also, Senior Staff will lead interactive worship songs, and counselors will facilitate devotionals in the cabins.

### Food Service

Campers will have 3 buffet meals daily at their campsite starting with dinner on arrival day and ending with breakfast on the day of departure. We serve kid-friendly meals and offer alternatives such as cereal, fruit, salad, and sandwiches to meet dietary preferences. Please note that we are unable to accommodate special dietary needs. Campers will not be allowed to bring their own meals or use the campsite kitchens. Campers will have daily "canteen" (included in the registration fee) which consists of soda and choice of candy, snacks, or ice cream. Campers will also be served milk and cookies before bedtime each day. We have water available at all activities and ask campers to drink multiple glasses of water at each meal to help prevent dehydration and heat related illness.

### Camp Tuition

Tuition for each session is \$498. The tuition for all sessions includes a \$166 non-refundable registration fee per session. In addition to lodging, food, supervision, and program, tuition includes a camp picture, all craft supplies, and daily canteen.

- To Register: send \$166.00 with completed registration forms to the summer camp office or you may register and make payments online at [www.campallen.org](http://www.campallen.org). Please note that your registration will be incomplete until all paperwork is completed.
- Campers who register for Session A or Session C will receive a discounted tuition of \$450.
- All balances are due by May 1<sup>st</sup>.
- We are unable to register or hold places for campers by phone.
- The \$166 is deducted from the total camp tuition. This registration fee is non-refundable unless registration is denied due to lack of space.
- Refunds will be made of all payment, less the deposit, if camper is ill and we receive a written physician's confirmation with cancellation. There are no refunds after a camper has been admitted to camp.
- A \$25 fee will be applied if a camp session is changed after April 15th.

### Online Registration

We are pleased to offer you online registration as another way to register your child for summer camp. You will find the instructions online at [www.campallen.org](http://www.campallen.org) under summer camp. Please note that you must at least pay the \$166 deposit and complete all forms for your camper to be considered "registered." Once you have completed the online registration for your camper, the summer camp office will send you a confirmation letter and a packet of forms that need parent/ guardian signatures. **YOUR CAMPER'S REGISTRATION IS NOT COMPLETE UNTIL THESE FORMS ARE SIGNED AND RETURNED.**



### Camp Scholarships

Scholarships are available based on need and availability of funds. You can obtain an application by calling Camp Allen or by visiting our website. Ideally, Camp Allen will pay 1/3 of the camper' tuition, the parent or guardian will pay 1/3, and the camper's home church will pay 1/3. Ask your clergy about church scholarships and request that they write Camp Allen on your behalf. A limited number of full scholarships are available each year based on need until those funds are fully expended. Tax-deductible donations to the scholarship fund of any amount are always welcome.

### What to Bring

Pack enough clothes for the entire week, clearly labeling your camper's first and last name on everything. Laundry facilities are not available. Please also pack all of your camper's items in a single piece of luggage (duffel, suitcase, or trunk).

\*\*Optional items: bible, camera, stationary, envelopes & stamps, and a costume for the dance (you will be notified of the theme before your camper attends camp).



### What Not To Bring

Cell phones, I-pods, hand held gaming systems, radios, knives, firearms, fireworks, aerosols, alcohol, drugs, non-prescription drugs or topicals, tobacco products, money, curling irons, hot rollers, DVD players or laptops. Camp Allen is not responsible for jewelry, clothes, or valuables left at camp. Driving personal automobiles by campers or counselors on the campgrounds is not allowed. Campers are not permitted to have electronics; these items will be collected by the campsite staff and may be picked up by parents on Saturday.

### Phoning or Visiting

We are fully conscious of our great responsibility in the care of your child. In the case of any emergency, either physical or otherwise, you will be notified promptly. Consequently, we do not allow personal phone calls, either incoming or outgoing, or personal visitation during the camp session due to the interruption to the schedule and the effect on camper morale. If a serious concern arises, you may contact the camp director at 936-825-7175 to discuss the situation. If it is an after-hours emergency, please page 979-209-2125. Inform the operator that you wish to contact Camp Allen.



### Arrival Procedure

Check-in is held at the sports pavilion at 4:00pm on registration day. Campers are not able to register before 4:00pm or go to the campsites before checking in at the pavilion. Camp Allen T-shirts, camper bags, caps, post cards and stamps are available for purchase at the camp store at the pavilion during check-in.



### Departure Procedure

At registration, the name and phone number of the person authorized to pick up the camper at 9:00am on Saturday will be written on the registration master list. On Saturday morning, a guard will be posted at the entrance to the campsite area. The person who is designated to pick up a camper must present photo identification to the guard. When picking up your camper, please be sure to collect all of the camper's belongings before you leave. Camp Allen is not responsible for items left behind. Lost and found items will be kept at Camp Allen for 30 days and can be picked up during regular business hours. Should circumstances necessitate a change of designated pick-up person, Camp Allen must receive written instructions to that effect, including the name of the new designated pick-up person sent via fax to Camp Allen at 936-825-8495. If there is any reason to suspect a person may attempt unauthorized pick-up of a camper, please notify Camp Allen. Upon availability, parents may reserve hotel rooms for Friday night for convenient Saturday morning pickup by calling Camp Allen.

### Camper Mail

Mail is very important to your camper, especially those who are away from home for the first time. We encourage you to mail letters before the actual session begins, (or no later than Tuesday), to assure the camper receives them. Camp Allen makes no guarantee on postal delivery. You may also drop off your camper's mail at registration. Packages should be no larger than a shoebox. *All letters and packages must include:*

### Horsemanship Camp

Camp Allen's Horsemanship Camp is for 6<sup>th</sup> - 8<sup>th</sup> graders who have an interest in horseback riding and horse care. All experience levels are welcome. The camp is a three phase program consisting of fundamental steps of horsemanship, daily duties of caring for a horse, and riding skills on the trails and in the arena. Participants will ride everyday, in the arena, with the majority of the riding on our Camp Allen trails. Our Equestrian Center Manager will evaluate each camper and modify instruction accordingly. Campers receive individual and group instruction, facilitating growth and will have the opportunity to participate in most of the activities that our traditional summer camp program offers such as blobbing, canoeing, swimming, canteen, and the dance. Please note that if you are interested in registering for Horsemanship Camp, it will start on Sunday August 8<sup>th</sup> and end on Thursday August 12<sup>th</sup>.

Dear Parents and Guardians,

Camp Allen's first priority is the safety of your child. We strive to create a healthy, positive environment where campers can experience God's love and have a great time. However, there are inherent risks involved with all camping activities that no amount of caution, instruction, or expertise could completely eliminate. This document acts as a parental release and a covenant with our campers to respect Camp Allen, its property and staff, and fellow campers. Please read through this document completely and sign the release at the bottom of the page. Then read through the camper policies with your child and have them sign the agreement.

**The following behaviors are strictly forbidden at Camp Allen.**

- Damage of property, such as graffiti or vandalism
- Infliction of any sort of bodily harm to oneself or another person
- Participation in any variety of bullying (physical, emotional, relational, verbal, etc)
- Crude, harsh, sarcastic, or inappropriate language
- The use of all personal electronics (IPODS, cell phones, PSPs, MP3 players, etc)
- Possession of drugs, alcohol, tobacco, knives, firearms, or weapons of any kind
- Any behavior that could represent a danger to the safety of oneself or fellow campers
- Any behavior that circumvents the authority of the counselors, Sr. Staff, or adult campsite staff

I understand that these actions could endanger others or myself and will not be permitted at Camp Allen. Furthermore, I agree to avoid said actions and be held accountable for them. I will comply with any repercussions, which may include, but is not limited to, immediate dismissal from camp without financial reimbursement.
