

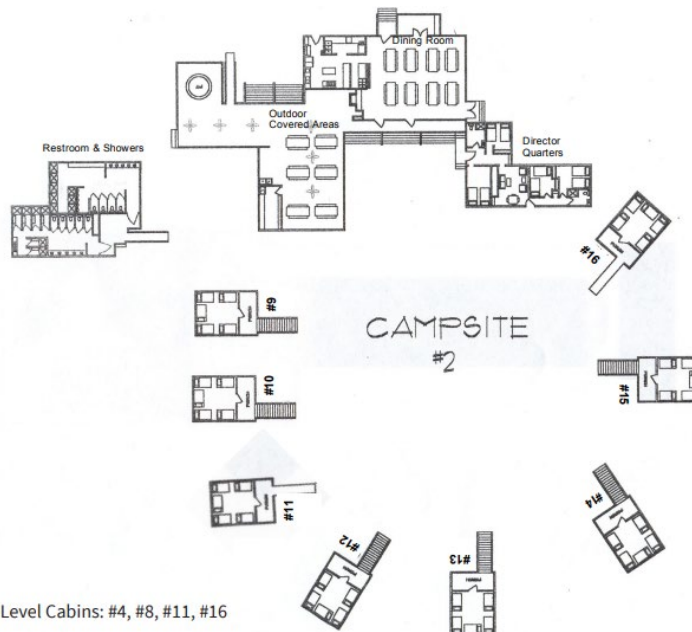
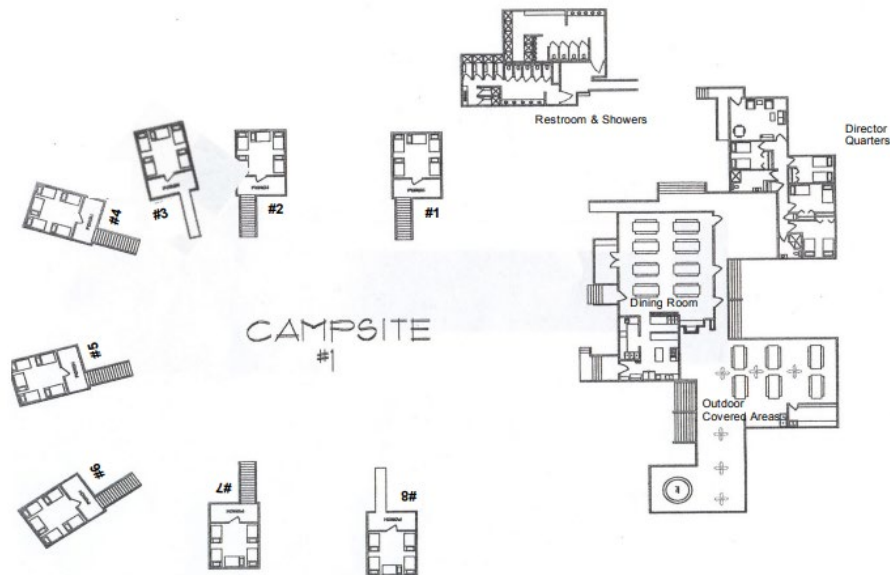
CABIN LAYOUTS AND ASSIGNMENTS

****Please verify which campsite you are assigned to as each campsite has a slightly different layout****

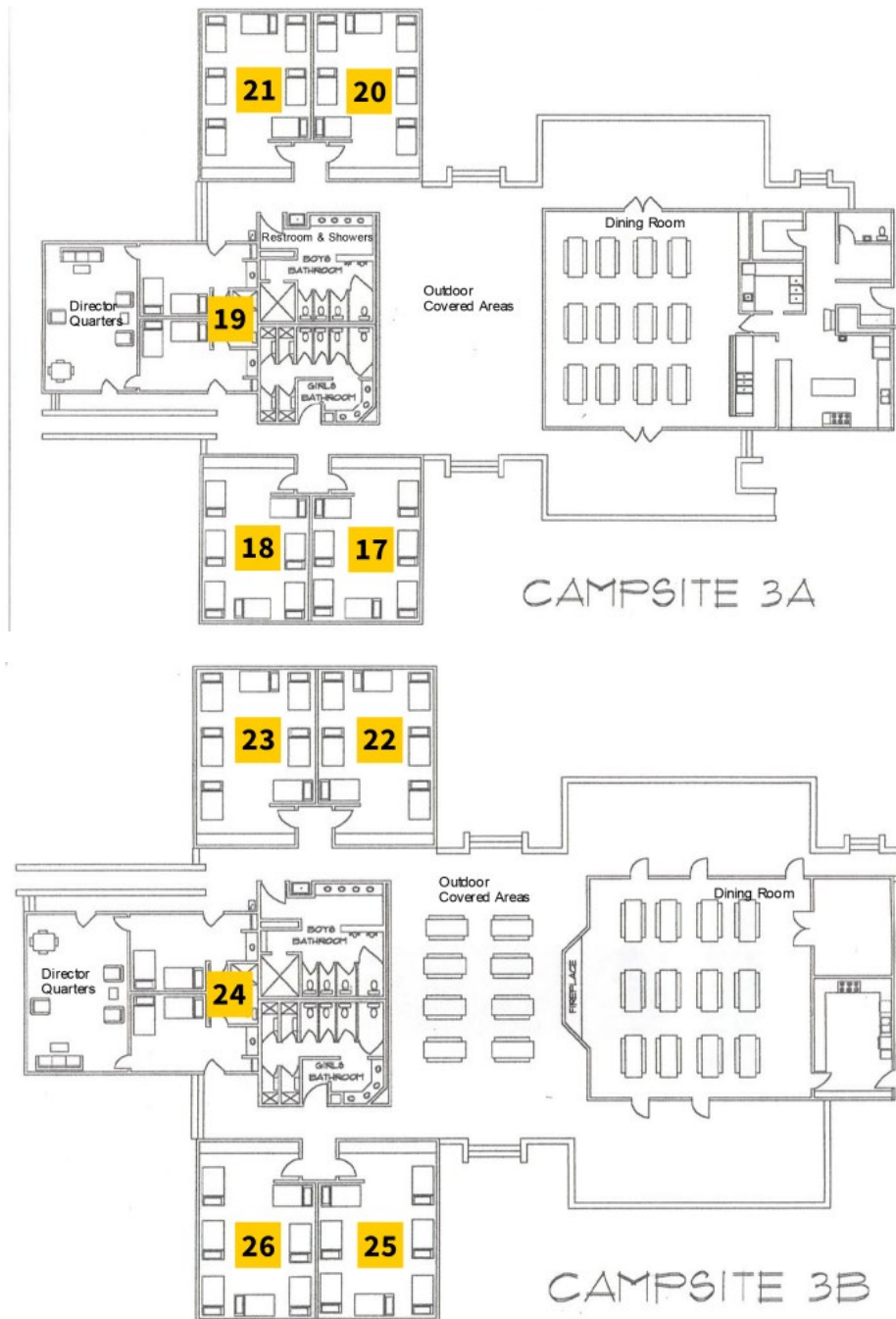
Campsites 1 and 2—8 “tree house” style cabins that sleep 10 people. The “DQ” (adult area) has 2 private bathrooms and 4 bedrooms with 3 beds in each room.

Cabins 4, 8 (Campsite 1) and 11, 16 (campsite 2) are ground level handicap cabins



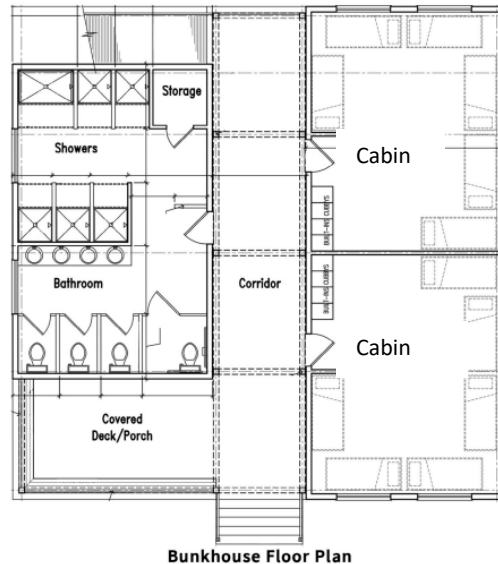
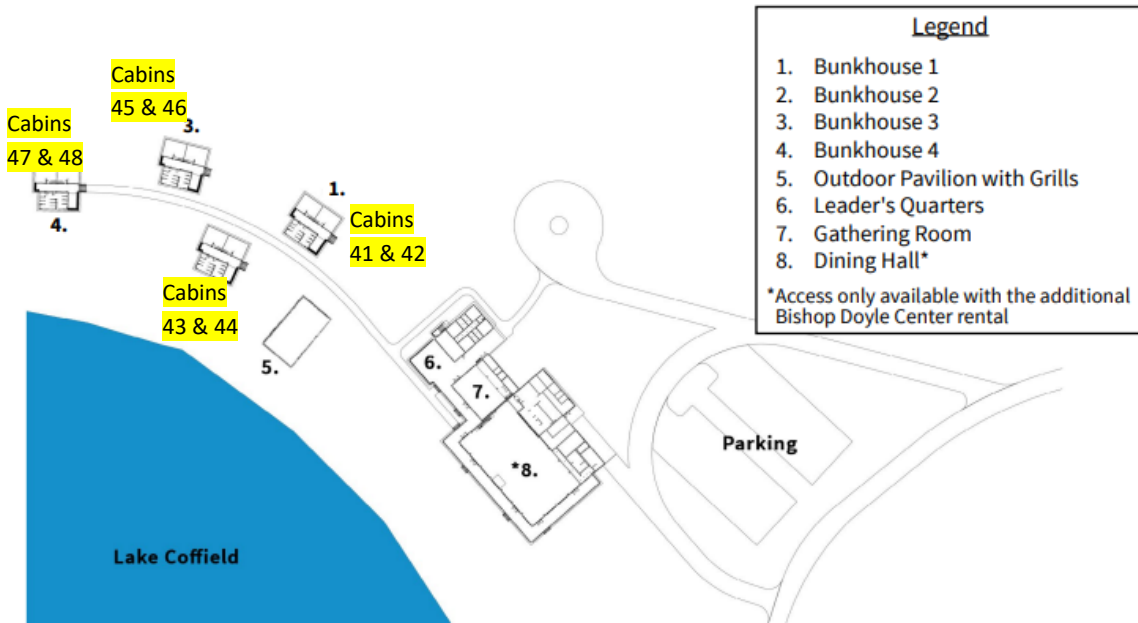
Ground Level Cabins: #4, #8, #11, #16

Campsite 3 A and B—Campsite 3 is divided into 2 identical buildings, A and B. Each building has 4 cabins that each sleeps 14 people. If your group is large enough to need more than 2 cabins for each gender, schools usually separate the girls in 3A and the boys in 3B. Cabins 19 and 24 are the “DQ” adult areas in this campsite that each sleep 6 with a private bathroom.



Campsite 4 is divided between 4 bunk houses that each have 2 cabins in them and share a bathroom. For this reason, both cabins in the bunk house should be the same gender. There is a sliding door that connects the 2 cabins that can be kept open if needed for supervision purposes. Each cabin contains 12 beds. The adult area “Leader’s Quarters” has 4 bedrooms with 4 beds and a private bathroom with showers in each.
